- Visit of the Chiesa di San Giovanni (St. John's Church is a gothic building which has undergone several transformations during the Renaissance and Baroque (sec. XVI-XVIII). In its present form the church dates from 1711, which explains the use of predominantly Baroque. The church belonged to the Franciscan order.
